# <u>Discussion and possible action on a community wide action plan due to extenuating circumstances created by the ASARCO strike</u>

There were discussions on the effect the strike will have on the town. Finance Director Williams told the council that the current finance is based on the town spending \$184,500 monthly. She told the council that going forward, she estimates approximately losing \$65,000 monthly, \$775,000 annually. She told the council that if the town has to start transferring from the LGIP Fund, the town will use the savings in approximately 14 months. It was discussed possibly having to make cuts to avoid having to use all the savings from the LGIP Fund. It was mentioned that this item should be listed on all future agendas and take the situation month by month. Vice-Mayor Smith moved to list this item on all future agendas or discussion. Council Member R. Lopez seconded the motion and the motion carried. 6-0
