Vice-Mayor Smith moved to accept a letter of interest and appointing Mr. Robert G. Manriquez to the position of council member. Council Member Lagunas seconded the motion and the motion carried. 4-0

Discussion and possible action on purchasing eleven sets of turnouts for the fire department in the amount of \$48,482.17 from United Fire/Discussion on purchasing a heavy-duty washer for the fire department in the amount of \$778.00 not including tax or shipping from Home Depot

Council Member Lagunas moved to purchase eleven sets of turnouts in the amount of \$48,482.17. Council Member Cruz seconded the motion and the motion carried. 5-0

Council Member Cruz moved to approve purchasing a heavy-duty washer for the fire department not to exceed \$950. Council Member Manriquez seconded the motion and the motion carried. 5-0

Council Member Lagunas moved to hire Heather Hetrick, Gloria Waddell and Monique Rivera for temporary/part-time employees until the three permanent employees return to work. Council Member Cruz seconded the motion and the motion carried. 4-1 Mayor Hetrick abstained.
