4. <u>Discussion and possible action approving Fiscal Year 2021-2022 Tentative Budget in the amount of \$6,110,000</u>

Finance Director Williams explained to the council that once the tentative budget is approved, the council can always make changes below the dollar amount that is in the tentative budget but cannot go over the dollar amount listed. She placed minimum wage amount to \$15.00 an hour, \$40,000 for the town hall roof, 20% increase in all fees, \$50,000 funding for senior center and raising the property tax. She mentioned that she is worried that the 2020 census will affect the town in 2023. Mayor Hetrick told the council that he has not heard anything from the Town of Winkelman concerning the IGA for Police Protection. Council Member Lagunas moved to approve Fiscal Year 2021-2022 Tentative Budget in the amount of \$6,110,000. Council Member Cruz seconded the motion and the motion carried. 4-0
