The Hayden Town Council will hold a public hearing for the purpose of discussing rate increases for water, sewer, garbage, all fees associated with the golf fees including golf passes, golf cart storage, golf cart rentals, RV spaces, rental fees for ramadas, club house and senior center effective August 1, 2021

Mayor Hetrick declared the Public Hearing open and anyone wishing to address the council at this time may do so. No one from the public had any comments. Mayor Hetrick closed the meeting to the public. Finance Director Williams reported that she had posted the notice on the website for sixty days. The resolutions will not go into effect for 30 days.

Mayor Hetrick opened the public hearing for discussion by council. Council Member Cruz stated that he has a concern about increasing the ramada and club house rentals. If the town increases these fees, then the areas need to be kept cleaned. He had gone to a party and the lights in the restrooms were not working, the water in the women's restroom was constantly running and there were no garbage cans.

Council Member Lagunas also mentioned that all the ramadas need to be cleaned. Mayor Hetrick advised the council that this incident had been brought up in a staff meeting and it is being taken care of by the General Superintendent.
